- Lacrosse is fun. This game is a gift and playing is a privilege. Everyone involved should be having a good time, coaches, players, refs, parents. We need to conduct ourselves in a manner that enables this.
 - A big part of playing competitive sports is enjoying the competition, particularly at the varsity level.
- There won't be tolerance for hate-language. You don't have to like everyone on the team, but you will treat them with respect.
- Everyone in the program needs to have a student mentality. Nobody here knows everything. Thinking you know everything limits your capacity to grow, be humble and learn.



Season Expectations

What am I looking for?

- Compete 100% of the time. It's easy to compete in games, everybody does that. Can you compete every rep of every practice? Can you compete when nobody is watching?
- Show up every day and be accountable to your team. It affects everyone in the program for individuals to not showing up, or not giving full effort. Don't take it easy on each other, nobody gets better that way. Iron sharpens Iron.
- I do not accept No-Call No-Shows. If you are going to miss a practice it needs to be for a reason and you need to let us know.
- Parents please do not schedule events when you know we have practice or games. If a
 birthday party or whatever else can be scheduled on a weekend please do that, players
 missing practice effects the whole team.



How to Get Better

Be coachable

- Do you want to be coached, or do you want to be left alone? Average players want to be left alone, good players want to be coached, great players want to be coached every day. (this is a Nick Saban quote)
- Seek coaching. We have great coaches, but also have great players who have become much better in a short period of time. Ask them to workout with you.

Be competitive, Work harder

- Weight room, speed and agility, wall ball, Watch game film/college lacrosse/PLL, play box lacrosse. If you want to be better, at least a few of these should be in your routine. We have 5 weeks until the spring season starts, if you want to be bigger/faster/stronger, etc. now is the time.
 - ➤ Side note: High school football players, basketball players, baseball players all watch college and/or professional levels of their sport. They can see what higher levels look like. Lacrosse players should be no different.



Other expectations

- For practices and games we show up early enough to play wallball and get warmed up.
- Fans, Parents, Etc. need to keep in mind that their job is to cheer for Pinnacle, not root against the other team OR tell the referees how to do their job.
- I don't speak with parents about playing time. The players always have the ability to ask where they sit on the depth chart and know I'm willing to put in extra work to those that ask. But that is between the coaching staff and the players. Don't ask, I won't have an answer for you.



Communication

- •All official team functions and communications will go through TeamSnap, download the app, unmute it and pay attention.
- •We will have groupme groups for offense and defense, and likely will have different ones for JV and Varsity. These groupme groups are not for parent or board input, the communication is for X's and O's discussion. If parents have questions they can reach out to the board or use teamsnap.




TeamSnap


- TeamSnap is our primary form of communication

- It is required for each player to update their availability for each practice, game, and event- this helps our coaches and board plan appropriately




Status Update View
